Tariq Rauf became the Director of SIPRI's *Disarmament, Arms Control and Non-Proliferation Programme* in February 2014. From 2002 to 2011, he was Head of the Verification and Security Policy Coordination Office, at the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), reporting to the Director General, in which capacity he dealt with high-priority verification cases involving Iran, Iraq, Libya, North Korea, South Korea and Syria. He was also the Alternate Head of the IAEA delegation to Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT) Conferences from 2002 to 2010, and the IAEA Liaison and Point-of-Contact for a number of multilateral control regimes and United Nations Security Council committees. In addition, he was Coordinator of Multilateral Approaches to the Nuclear Fuel Cycle at the IAEA from 2003 to 2012, in which capacity he set up the IAEA LEU Reserve at Angarsk, and led the IAEA LEU Bank project. He was a member of Canada's NPT delegation from 1986 to 2000. He served as Senior Advisor to the Chair of the 2014 NPT PrepCom. He has published widely on the NPT, nuclear fuel assurances and nuclear governance issues.
