

## **Amb. SERGEY BATSANOV (SHORT BIONOTE)**

Sergey Batsanov is a long-time practitioner and scholar in the field of international security, arms limitation and non-proliferation. From 1976 till 1989 he worked on the whole range of arms control and disarmament issues in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the USSR; then, in 1989-1993 was the Soviet, then Russian Ambassador to the Conference on Disarmament. Chairman of the Ad-Hoc Committee on Chemical Weapons in the penultimate year of negotiations on the CWC, and the Chair of the Final Drafting Group during the last year of negotiations in 1992. During 1993 -2004 worked in the Hague in the OPCW PrepCom, and then in the OPCW, as the Director for Special Projects, dealing, among other things, with the issues of compliance and implementation support. Participated in several NPT, as well as BWC and Sea-bed Treaty Review Conferences.

Since 2005 he the Director of the Geneva Office of Pugwash Conferences on Science and World Affairs. He is also a member of the International Advisory Board of the Geneva Center for the Democratic Control of Armed Forces (DCAF).
