Judith Reppy is a professor in the Department of Science and Technology Studies and a former director of the Peace Studies Program of Cornell University, with which she has been associated since 1973. She is also an adjunct member of the Department of Government. She has been a visiting fellow at Science & Technology Studies (Manchester University), the Science Policy Research Unit (Sussex University), and the Center for International Studies (MIT). She is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations and the Advisory Board of Women in International Security (WIIS). From 1995-2000 she served as co-chair of US Pugwash. In 2002-03 she served on the committee of the National Academies of Science on Research Standards and Practices to Prevent the Destructive Application of Biotechnology (the Fink committee), and 2005-06 she was a Phi Beta Kappa Visiting Scholar. Her current research interests include the export control regime for dual-use technologies and the possibility that a new biomedical military industrial complex is emerging in the USA.
