

## **Alessandro Pascolini's C.V.**

Alessandro Pascolini is a senior scholar at the University of Padua, where he was associate professor of theoretical physics, also teaching a course on “science for peace” at the Faculty of Political Sciences; he is lecturing on “Science Communication” in the Master in Science Communication of the Padua University. His scientific researches are in the fields of nuclear theoretical physics; history of science and science communication; technologies related to armaments and disarmament.

Since 1988 to 2002 he was in charge of a special program of the Italian National Institute of Nuclear Physics (INFN) for raising public awareness of science. In this context he produced some 70 scientific exhibitions in Italy and abroad. He has been awarded the Outreach Prize 2004 of the European Physical Society.

In 1968 he attended the second ISODARCO course; in 1970 was co-founder of the ISODARCO association and is presently vice-president and treasurer of this Institution; he regularly takes part in seminars, workshops and other activities of the Pugwash Conferences on Science and World Affairs; from 1973 to 1990 he acted as Secretary of the Italian national Pugwash group.
